How to Attempt a REAL Test

01 Know the Test Mode

If online – You'll give the test from home using the student portal.

If offline – You'll get your admit card with center details.

02 Download Your Admit Card (Offline Only)

Available 3 days before the test on your RTS Portal in 'My Document' section.

Check carefully for:

- Center address
- Timing
- Instructions

03 Test Day Checklist (Offline Only)

Bring these:

- Admit Card
- Valid ID Proof

Arrive at least 30 minutes early.

Frequently Asked Questions

Registration & Access

Q: Do I need to register for every test separately?

A: No! One-time registration gives you access to the entire test series — both online and offline tests.

Q: I missed the registration deadline. Can I still join?

A: If the series is ongoing, late registration is allowed for upcoming tests. Keep checking the official link or announcements on your portal.

Test Format & Mode

Q: Will the test be online or offline?

A: Some tests are online, others offline. Always check your test schedule and admit card for the correct mode.

Q: Where is my exam center?

A: Your exam center details will be on the admit card, which is released around 3 days before the test.

Q: Can I change my test mode from offline to online (or vice versa)?

A: Test mode cannot be changed.

Exam Day

Q: How early should I reach the exam center?

A: At least 30 minutes before the reporting time to avoid any last-minute rush.

After the Test

Q: When will I get my results?

A: Results are usually available within a few days for online and for NEET offline it will take about 2 week+.

Q: Will I get an All India Rank (AIR)?

A: Yes! You'll receive AIR for each test that you will take on the scheduled exam day based on overall performance.

Q: What if I miss a test?

A: No problem. You can take the test online. You can still access the question paper, solutions, and analysis later to practice.

Test Experience & Quality

Q: Is the paper difficulty the same as actual competitive exams?

A: Yes! The tests are designed to closely match the difficulty, pattern, and pressure of real entrance exams. But we also keep in mind the capability of all students — our goal is not to demotivate anyone, but to help you grow, learn, and improve with every attempt. Think of it as a smart practice ground, not a judgment!

Q: Will invigilators be present in offline tests?

A: Yes, offline exams follow a proper exam-day protocol with invigilation and discipline.
